**NOTICE TO OWNERS OF TOSHIBA BRAND SATELLITE SERIES 5000 NOTEBOOK
COMPUTER MODEL X1Z OR Z59**

Read this notice carefully as it may affect your rights.

This notice was approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice.

THE CLASS ACTION

This notice is directed to all persons who purchased, not for the purpose of resale, a new Toshiba brand Satellite Series 5000 notebook computer model X1Z or Z59 (the "Satellite 5000 Notebook") from a Canadian retailer.

The class action seeks, among other things, an order requiring Toshiba of Canada Limited and its parent company, Toshiba Corporation, to refund all or part of the purchase price of the Satellite 5000 Notebook, which the plaintiffs allege was defectively designed. Toshiba denies these allegations. The merits of the action have not yet been determined.

THE CERTIFICATION ORDER

On March 2, 2007, the Superior Court of Justice certified the action *Bondy v. Toshiba*, Court File No. 03-CV-1679, as a class action and appointed Jeffrey Charles Bondy and Nicolas John MacPherson as representative plaintiffs of the class defined as:

All persons in Canada who purchased, not for the purpose of resale, a new Toshiba brand Satellite Series 5000 notebook computer model X1Z or Z59 from a Canadian retailer.

If you are a member of the class, your rights will be affected.

Each member of the class who does not opt out of the class action will be bound by the terms of any judgment or settlement in the class action. If the class action is successful, you may be entitled to share in the amount of any award or settlement recovered, or be required to take part in an individual hearing to prove your own damages.

This notice is a summary of the terms of the certification order and the further October 11 and November 29, 2007 court orders. If there is any conflict between the provisions of this notice and the terms of those orders, those orders shall prevail.

LEGAL FEES AND DISBURSEMENTS

Counsel have entered into an agreement with the representative plaintiffs with respect to legal fees and disbursements. The agreement provides that counsel will not receive payment for their work unless the class action is successful or costs are received from the defendants.

The plaintiffs have received financial support from the Class Proceedings Fund. As a result, if the class action is successful, the Class Proceedings Fund is

entitled to 10% of any monetary award or settlement plus the amount of any financial support it paid to the plaintiffs.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

YOU MUST OPT OUT IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLASS ACTION

Members of the class who do **not** wish to participate in the class action must opt out of the class action. If you wish to opt out of the class action, send the opt-out form at the bottom of this notice or a signed letter providing the same information, or obtain an opt-out form from www.toshiba5000classaction.com, or from counsel listed above.

A class member who opts out of the class action will not be entitled to participate in the class action or recover any proceeds of settlement or judgment if obtained. His or her right to pursue a claim in a separate proceeding will not be affected.

No class member will be permitted to opt out of the class action after March 3, 2008 at 5:00 ET.
